## 2021 Heritage Jr. Livestock Auction

Sunday May 16<sup>th</sup>, 10:00am Auction Starts

All Large Livestock will be sold by the pound.

Maximum Pay Weights:

Swine 250 lbs.

Sheep 150 lbs.

Steer 1300 lbs.

Goat 105 lbs.

This is a **TERMINAL SALE** there will be **NO LIVE PICK UP!**

Market prices for resale will be posted morning of the sale at the Livestock Office. Resale animals will be processed (NO LIVE PICK-UP). Buyers will receive the resale value on the day of the sale.

Small Animal Livestock (Turkeys) will be sold by the head.

Small Animal Livestock (Rabbit Meat Pens, and Broiler Meat Pens) will be sold by the pen.

Small Livestock will be processed and must be picked up by the seller at the Fairgrounds on Wednesday May 19<sup>th</sup>. Any animal not picked up will be donated to the local Foodbank.

### Buyers Breakfast

Breakfast will be served from 8:30am to 9:30am. Buyers will receive 2 tickets to the Buyers Breakfast at the Registration Desk when picking up Buyer Numbers.

### Buyers Lunch

Lunch will be served from 1:30pm to 3:00pm. Buyers will receive 2 tickets to the Buyers Lunch with the purchase of an animal. Thank you to the CCC Heritage Foundation and England's for providing lunch!

# Decisions to make as a Buyer!

## Resale

If you wish to support a youth exhibitor by purchasing an animal at the sale but do not want the animal, you mark **RESALE** on the sales invoice. With this method, you as the buyer will pay the difference between the price you bid and the market value of the animal on the day of the sale.

Market prices will be posted morning of the sale. You will not receive any meat, nor will you take delivery of the animal. The animal will be processed, and you will receive resale value for the animal.

Only Large Livestock will be available for resale: Beef, Sheep, Swine and Goat.

## Custom Processing

If you wish the fair to ship your purchased animal to a processing plant to be process for your own use, you will mark **Custom Process** on the sale invoice. After processing, carcasses will be delivered to the meat locker specified for each species, for cut and wrap. It is **IMPERITIVE YOU** as the buyer contact the meat locker (processor) for your preference of cut and wrap, and that **YOU** pick up your meat as soon as possible. Meat not picked up in a timely manner will be donated to the local Foodbank.

The **ONLY** animals available for processing are:

Turkeys, Rabbits, Chickens, Swine, Sheep, Steers and Goats.

## Payment Information

Payment is encouraged the day of the Auction. Payments can be made by Cash, Check, Credit Card (with a 3% fee) or PayPal at [info@ccheritage.net](mailto:info@ccheritage.net). Buyers will be invoiced after the completion of the sale. After 30 days a 1.5% interest will be assessed monthly on monies owed. Any payments not received after 60 days will be sent to collections.

Note: A 200 lb hog should yield 130 to 140 lbs of meat.

A 1,000 lb steer should yield 480 to 500 lbs of meat.

A 100 lb lamb or goat should yield 45 to 50 lbs of meat.

You will receive whole Turkeys, Chickens or Rabbits.

*As the buyer it is your responsibility to contact and communicate with the processor of your choice about your cut and wrap options.*
