(Energy) Conservation Demand Management (CDM) PLAN

The Hornepayne Community Hospital is a public agency (hospital) located at 278 Front Street, Hornepayne, ON, P0M 1Z0.

Operation:

1. Facility used for Hospital/Long-Term Care/Emergency/Family Medicine Clinic purposes
2. Administrative Offices and related facilities
3. Operation is conducted in total square footage area of 29,000 feet.
4. The hours of operation per week are 168 hours.
5. The annual flow – water is not metered.
6. Energy type is electric.

CDM Plan 2014 – 2019 is as follows:

1. Install low voltage lighting – interior and exterior
2. Take advantage of Hydro One initiatives
3. Explore the feasibility of added insulation in the attic
4. Programmable heaters in areas that are empty

We anticipate that this will net savings of approximately \$5,000/annually. We are at a disadvantage, as we do not have a lot of options due to our location.

Initiatives Already in Place:

1. The Hornepayne Community Hospital has already installed 3m film on all windows that has saved us \$6,000 per year.
2. We have purchased, through the OHA¹, a Hospital purchasing plan to be billed at a flat rate instead of being billed at peak rates.
3. Energy-wise program – facility wide – ie. turning off lights when not in use, turning heat down on weekends, etc.
