

Mary Elizabeth Bach "Betty" 1915-2004

Mary E. "Betty" Bach age 88, of Sand Point died Thursday morning, March 18, at her home while under hospice care.

She was born October 20, 1915 in Bad Axe to the late Warren and Mary (Sturtridge) Slack and lived in Huron County most her life. She did attend Hillsdale College where in 1936; she received her bachelor's degree in business.
