Applicants must be a junior or senior in high school or a freshman in college.

Applicants must be a member of ASAA.

Applicants must write an essay outlining why they are deserving of the scholarship. This essay should document the applicants' commitment to the Saddlebred community by citing their involvement in ASAA sponsored events such as shows.

Applicants must provide evidence to the Selection Committee of academic success.

Applicants may provide up to 2 personal letters of reference, however, they are not required.

Applicants must agree to allow their photo to be used in ASAA promotional materials.

The Board of Directors reserves the right to interview any or all applicants.

Any and all funds from the abovementioned scholarship are to be used for educational purposes only. These funds will be paid by ASAA directly to the educational institution designated by the recipient of the scholarship.
