Ordinances: Ordinances are Public Record and can be viewed during normal business hours at the City Municipal Complex. Below is a listing of various subject areas in which we have local Ordinances. This listing is not exclusive. We also adhere to all applicable state and federal code/laws.

- **Licenses and Permits:** Contact the 501-843-7686 for more information.
 - **Business License:** All businesses, including home-based businesses, **MUST** purchase a Business License to operate.
 - **Building Permits:** You **MUST** purchase a Building Permit if you plan on building any structure on your property. This includes but is not limited to fences and storage buildings.
 - **HVAC and Plumbing:** You **MUST** purchase a permit for any HVAC or plumbing work you have done. This includes but is not limited to replacement of your Furnace and/or Air Conditioner and Hot Water Heater. This includes but is not limited to fences and storage buildings.
 - **Yard/Garage Sales:** You **MUST** obtain a permit for each Yard and/or Garage Sale. There is no cost for the permit; however, you may only hold four (4) Yard or Garage Sales per calendar year.
- **Animal Control:** Pets are required to be on a leash or in a fence when outside the home. You are limited to five (5) dog and/or cats at any one time. Contact Animal Control for additional information about other species.
- **Outside Burning:** Burning limbs leaves and other yard waste is permitted. Burning of household trash is not permitted.

NO BURNING IS PERMITTED WHEN THE CITY IS UNDER A BURN BAN
- **Firearms:** Discharge of any firearm within the city limits **IS PROHIBITED**.
- **Fireworks:** Discharge, Shooting or Exploding of Fireworks within the city limits **IS PROHIBITED** except as allow per Ordinance on Special Occasions.

Other Information:

- **Ambulance Service:** Ward contracts with Southern Paramedic Service to provide Paramedic Level Emergency Services. If you have an **Emergency**, call **911**. If you have a Non-Emergency, call 877.672.4595. Please visit www.southernparamedic.com for more information.
- **Sanitation/Trash Service:** Ward contracts with WCA for household trash pickup. Contact WCA at 870-255-4001 or the City Water Department for more information.
- **Lonoke County CODE RED Operation:** The County utilizes a **CODE RED Warning System** to notify you via your cell phone of Weather Warnings/Watches and in the event of an emergency situation. Go to www.coderedweb.com to enroll.
- **City Rental Property:** The City rents various properties for your use such as the City's Gym, Cafeteria and Ball Fields. Visit www.wardparksandrec.com for more information.
