Mayor Carrie Roecks called the meeting to order at 7:00PM. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Roll call took place. The following were present: Carrie Roecks, Micki Harnois, Clint Stevenson, Dave Thompson, William Benson and Jim Oshanick. Deputy Clerk, Heidi Johnson and several residents were also in attendance.

Mr. Thompson made a motion to approve the amended agenda. Mr. Benson seconded the motion. Motion was carried.

Mr. Thompson made a motion to approve the minutes for the special meeting on March 16, 2016. Mr. Stevenson seconded the motion. Motion was carried.

Mr. Benson made a motion to approve the minutes for the regular meeting on March 16, 2016. Mr. Stevenson seconded the motion. Motion was carried.

LAYNE MERRITT, J.U.B. ENGINEERING

Lagoon Liner Replacement Project

Mr. Merritt stated that the preconstruction meeting for Lagoon #3 had been held and that the next step is to start the construction permitting process. He also stated that there are some paperwork issues that are delaying the Acceptance of Completion on the first phase of the project. These issues will be addressed soon.

Missile Base Road

Mr. Merritt told council that the Freight Mobility application deadline is April 23, 2016. Mr. Oshanick asked if Missile Base Road is still the State's responsibility to maintain or if it's the Town's obligation. Mrs. Harnois confirmed that the maintenance of the road is the Town's responsibility.

First Street Sidewalk

 Mr. Merritt stated that he is starting to get the design projects back and discussed what is required in regard to ADA (Americans with Disabilities Act) liability. Mr. Merritt asked that the council if they could make a motion to allow Mayor Roecks to sign/approve the construction amendment of for the funding agreement when it becomes available, so as to move things along quicker.

Mr. Merritt submitted the Professional Services Agreement for the funding of the Well #4, totaling \$65,500.00

Mr. Merritt presented a spreadsheet with the summary of costs for the Lagoon Liner with a portion of CIPP (cured in-place pipe). He also gave council a spreadsheet of additional engineering fees for miscellaneous projects totaling \$4077.79.

Mr. Oshanick made a motion to pay the miscellaneous additional engineering fees totaling \$4077.79. Mr. Thompson seconded. Motion was carried.

Mr. Thompson brought up the company Fire Mountain Farms. This company is a Biosolids removal entity who will be cleaning Lagoon #3. In order for them to do the project, the Department of Ecology requires a public hearing. The council agreed that Fire Mountain Farms can hold the public hearing at Town Hall.

Mr. Oshanick made a motion to authorize the mayor to approve the supplemental amendment to the First Street Sidewalk Project agreement. Mrs. Harnois seconded. Motion was carried.
