CURBSIDE ELECTRONIC WASTE RECYCLING

All items must be scheduled for collection. To schedule a pickup, please call Customer Care Center at (800) 437-1759 and let us know you live in Mount Pleasant Township in Westmoreland County. Please provide your name, address, phone number and the type of electronic waste item we will be collecting. You will be given a date for the collection of your recyclable electronic device. Please note: this date may or may not be on your regular trash collection day, as these items are collected separately. Items must be placed at curb by $G a \cdot m \cdot$ on your scheduled collection day. No electronic items will be collected in alleys. This service is NOT available for commercial establishments. Electronics recycling is limited to 3 items per household.

LEAF WASTE COLLECTION

BULK WASTE AND WHITE GOODS COLLECTION

Place curbside by 6 $a \cdot m \cdot on$ your scheduled collection day. One large item per household allowed each month.

Refrigerant containing items such as refrigerators, dehumidifiers, AC units, etc. must have a sticker on it saying the refrigerant has been properly removed by a PA certified company/technician.


