

Resident Artist Call Prospectus for the d'Art Center

The d'Art Center's mission is to connect our surrounding community to the visual arts. D'Art accomplishes this by providing a space for the community to view local and national exhibitions, take art classes, attend free art workshops, and to connect with local artists who are working onsite in their studios at our center. The d'Art Center also participates in outreach programming and partnerships to further accomplish its mission goal. The center also provides art focused summer camp programming for the community.

The d'Art Center houses working artist studios on-site. **Rent ranges from \$125 - \$450 and is determined by the square footage.** These professional resident artists create and sell original artworks that represent a variety of media and aesthetics. Resident artists also engage in community service by interfacing with the public, providing free demonstrations and discussions.

Artists who wish to become a resident artist and have an onsite studio at the center must be mission aware and be able to donate their time occasionally to community outreach programming, center programming, and contribute to center operations. These requirements include the following :

1. Volunteerism is 100% required.
2. Resident artists must contribute a total of 5 hours monthly to onsite programming, outreach programming, and/or exhibition installation/deinstallation as requested by d'Art Staff.
3. If there is an exhibition installed, resident artists are required to sign up for a gallery sitting shift once monthly. These shifts take place from 10am - 1:30 or 1:30 - 4:30 Tuesdays - Saturdays, and 5:00 - 8:00 on Thursdays.

To apply, please submit the below items to abradley@d-artcenter.org, and include "Artist Application" as the email subject heading.

- 7-10 high resolution PDF, PNG, or JPG examples of your original artworks that are representative of works you typically create

- An updated resume or CV that includes artistic experience, accomplishments, and credentials
- An updated artist statement, complete with your artistic process and typical medium(s)
- An artist biography
- A short written explanation of why you want to join the d'Art Center as an artist, and how you plan to contribute to the d'Art Center mission
- The filled out resident application form (page 3 of this document)

The application process:

- Completed applications are reviewed by d'Art staff and Artists who make it through the initial review panel (done using the digital images only) will then be contacted for an in person interview at the d'Art Center. Artists who did not make it through the initial review panel will also be notified within two weeks of submitting their application.
- Artists will present their work (in portfolio form, although those who wish to bring actual pieces may), and will also be interviewed to ensure that the artist is also compliant with the d'Art Center's mission and artist requirements.
- Artists will be notified of results within two weeks of appointment.
- If the accepted artist decides to become part of the d'Art Center, the process of lease development will begin with the Executive Director.
