## *RecoveryWerks! Core Values: Unconditionally Accept Our Members*

*We accept people where they are and meet them where they are. We have to because where else could they but where they are?" Anonymous*

Unconditional acceptance does not mean approval of a member's actions or lifestyle. We unconditionally accept the substance user, but we disapprove of substance use. We unconditionally accept a member who has committed a crime, but we disapprove of the crime. We unconditionally accept a parent who is enabling their loved one, but we disapprove of enabling.



Unconditional acceptance is meeting people where they are, not where we think they should be. We do not ask them to move towards us. We move toward them. Standing where they stand, we share our experience, love, and understanding. Sobriety from substances and codependency is our goal, but we do not require sobriety for acceptance, but rather a willingness to be sober.

We acknowledge that we do not cause change in our members. God causes the change. Recovery is not about us. Recovery is about our Higher Power.
