#### HOMEMAKING DIVISON RULES

- 1. All general rules and regulations of the Jim Wells Fair Association will apply.
- 2. No entry fee will be charged for placing exhibits in the fair; however, all youth entries must be a member of 4-H, FFA, FCCLA or an organized club and must sell one (1) fair membership. All adults (19-59) must be a member of the Jim Wells County Fair Association. The Senior Citizen division is open to any county resident 60 years of age or over.

# AGE GROUPS:

GROUP 1:	Pee-Wee (age as of September 1st)	Kinder – 2 <sup>nd</sup> Grade
GROUP 2:	Junior (age as of September 1st)	3 <sup>rd</sup> , 4 <sup>th</sup> , 5 <sup>th</sup> Grade
GROUP 3:	Intermediate (age as of September 1st)	6 <sup>th</sup> , 7 <sup>th</sup> , 8 <sup>th</sup> Grade
GROUP 4:	Senior (age as of September 1st)	9 <sup>th</sup> , 10 <sup>th</sup> ,11 <sup>th</sup> ,12 <sup>th</sup> Grade
GROUP 5:	Adult	19-59 years
GROUP 6:	Senior Citizens	60 years or over

- 3. All entries **MUST** be the complete work of the exhibitor and completed within one (1) calendar year of the previous fair. All entries must be undamaged and clean. Unfinished entries will not be accepted.
- 4. Any entry which has been entered and judged previously in the Jim Wells County Fair, cannot be exhibited or judged again.

- 5. Participants may enter as many entries in any given division, but only one (1) per class.
- 6. Entries that do not follow the Homemaking Division Rules will be disqualified. Disqualifications may occur during judging. Acceptance of an entry at check-in is not an acknowledgement that an entry meets all Homemaking Division Rules. The Superintendent of each department has the authority to reject unworthy exhibits or items not packaged according to division rules or reclassify any articles. <u>Food items</u> requiring refrigeration will not be accepted.
- 7. All entries must be pre-registered to be eligible for judging. Registration of entries must have the exact description of each entry. Entry forms will be available from Texas A&M AgriLife Extension Office or Jim Wells County Fair Website. Entries must be turned in by September 3, 2021 no later than 4:30 p.m. No late entries will be accepted. Entry forms must be complete; no entries can be filled out at the Extension Office.
- 8. Entries must be taken to the Home Economics Building on Monday, October 18, 2021 between 3:00 p.m. and 7:00 p.m. No late arrivals will be accepted. All index cards for entries must be completed and placed with entry before checking in with the department superintendent. Food items must have a copy of the recipe, without participant's name included with the item. Entry description must match item turned in.
- Judge's orientation will begin at 8:30 a.m. followed by judging of items at 9:00 a.m. on Tuesday, October 19<sup>th</sup> and Wednesday, October 20<sup>th</sup>. Only the judges, superintendents, appointed tabulators, and extension office staff will be allowed during judging.
- 10. Entries will remain on display until Saturday, October 23, 2021 until 5:00 p.m. Only a portion of the cakes and pies will be displayed, and remaining's must be removed from the Home Economics Building after judging between 5:00 p.m. and 7:00 p.m. on Tuesday, October 19, 2021. Other items which must be removed on Tuesday are entries that were disqualified
- 11. In each division a class will be established when there are at least two (2) similar entries. If there are fewer than two (2) entries, the entry will be placed in the next closest appropriate category or placed in a miscellaneous category.
- 12. Entries will be judged and given ribbons according to scores received. Ribbons are awarded based on Blue: 90-100; Red: 80-89. Class Champion Ribbons will be awarded in each Class when there are two (2) or more entries. In order for an entry to be a Division Champion, it must be a Class Champion.

Point System: Exhibitors may enter as many items as desired but only the top 25 high scored entries will be used for determining Grand Champion and Reserve Grand Champion in each age division. Exhibitors will still be awarded ribbons for all items. Points will be tabulated as follows: score from individual class, +5 points for Class Champion + 10 points for Division Champion.

Example #1: 92 points (score from item) +5 because it was Class Champion = 97 points.

Example #2: 95 points (score from item) +5 for Class Champion +10 points for Division Champion. 95+5+10=110 points for item

In case of a tie, the individual with the most Division Champion Winners will be the winner.

14. The Grand Champion and Reserve Grand Champion Banner and Plaque will be awarded to the individuals with the most points in each age group: Pee Wee, Junior, Intermediate, Senior, Adult and Senior Citizen.

All age division runner-ups will receive a Reserve Grand Champion Banner and Plaque.

The Grand and Reserve Grand Champion Awards will be presented at the Award's Ceremony on Saturday October 23, 2021. The Grand Champion Award may only be awarded to the same individual two (2) consecutive years in any age group.

- 15. Participants **cannot** place sale stickers on items.
- All entries need to be picked up on Saturday, October 23, 2021 between 5:00 p.m. and 7:00 p.m. The Homemaking Division will not be responsible for unclaimed items.
- 17. Any protest must be lodged immediately, with a \$250.00 **NON-REFUNDABLE DEPOSIT**, to the Homemaking Division Superintendent. Protest Committee will consist of Homemaking Division Superintendent, the entry's Division Superintendent and Fair Board President.

## **FOOD DEPARTMENT**

- 1. All General Rules of the Jim Wells County Fair apply to this department.
- 2. A copy of your recipe must be attached to bottom of your plate/food item when turning in item, or it will result in a 5-point deduction. **Make sure your name is not on this copy.**
- 3. Canned products such as pickles, canned fruits and vegetables should be shown in standard pint or quart jars. (Example: Kerr, Ball, Etc.) All home canning products must contain a label. All canned items will be inspected at check in, if not sealed or spoiled in any manner item will be disqualified.
- 4. Jelly, Jams, and Preserves can be entered in the standard **4 or 8 ounce jars**.
- 5. Cakes, Pies and Bread items will be whole when entered. After judging, a portion will be cut and placed on display with ribbon(s). **5 POINTS WILL BE DEDUCTED IF CAKE, PIE OR BREADS ARE PRE-CUT.** The remainder will be returned to the exhibitor between the hours of 5:00 p.m. and 7:00 p.m. on October 19, 2021. If not picked up, the item will be disposed of.
- 6. Four (4) pieces of candy, cookies, cupcakes, muffins, or rolls will be required for one exhibit. Baked exhibits and candy should be placed in a **clear hinged container**. Breads should be placed in large zip-lock bags. Items must be packaged to be accepted along with copy of recipe.
- 7. Containers will be available to purchase at the County Extension Office between October 12 15, 2021 from 8:00 a.m. 5:00 p.m.
- 8. Cakes should be placed on a foil covered cardboard and covered with **CLEAR PLASTIC.** Sheet cakes that are unable to be removed from the pan may be shown in a disposable pan.
- 9. Points will be deducted if the exhibitor's name is found anywhere on entry.
- 10. Display Cakes will be judges on creativity only. No taste testing.
- 11. FOOD ITEMS NEEDING REFRIGERATION WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.

- 2. Attach a 3x5 index card explaining the location season and the effect desired. **5 POINTS WILL BE DEDUCTED IF 3X5 INDEX CARD IS NOT ATTACHED TO PHOTO.**
- 3. **Size of Photographs:** All photos must be 8x10 in size or 5x7. If you plan to enter same picture from County 4-H Photography Contest in the spring, size must be 8x10 or 5x7.
- 4. **Mounting of Photographs:** All prints must be permanently mounted solid on photographic mount board (mat board is available at Hobby Lobby, Michael's, or Photo Store). **Photos cannot be framed. If framed, it will not be accepted.** Mount board is not foam of any kind, poster board or sponge board.
- 5. **Negatives/Picture Disks: NOT** required in any divisions.
- 6. **Picture Story Division:** Digital entry (one photo) containing three (3) smaller images and minimal text that tells a story.
- 7. All entries must have been taken on/after the Jim Wells County Fair of last year.
- 8. Read class divisions carefully as pictures not entered in correct category or following category descriptions will be disqualified.

# **Photography Class Descriptions:**

# **Animals-Domestic:**

Photos focusing on the various animals that have been tamed and made fit for a human environment. To be considered domesticated, the animal must have their behavior, life cycle, or physiology systemically altered as a result of being under human control for many generations.

Examples: Chickens, Cows, Dogs, Cats, Hamsters, Horses, Pigs, Sheep, Goat, etc.

(All waterfowl (ducks and geese) should be entered in Animals-Wildlife)

### **Animals-Wildlife:**

Category focuses on animals not typically tamed or domesticated and commonly found in the wilderness or the bodies of water throughout the country and world. Photos can be of wildlife in nature, zoos, and/or petting zoos.

Examples: Birds, Deer, Elephants, Snakes, Whales, etc.

#### Catch-All:

Photos that **DO NOT FIT** into one of the other categories.

NOT ALLOWED: A duplicate photo also entered in another category.

#### **Details & Macro:**

Getting in close is the name of the game for this category. The goal is to zoom in close on an object to see its finer details or to make small objects appear life-sized or larger that we do not normally get to see with the naked eye.

Examples: Insect eyes, veins on a lea, a reflection in a water droplet, etc.

#### **Elements of Design:**

Images use of graphic elements of design. Photos that showcase line, shape, pattern, form, texture, perspective, etc. Photo can consist of any subject matter.

Examples: Line, pattern, perspective, shape, etc.

Not Allowed: Digital creations or graphic designs made in software such as Photoshop, InDesign or Illustrator.

### Enhanced:

A single photo that has been technically manipulated to be an abstract, panoramic, stitched or composite image. Other variations are allowed as well.

Example: Software edited composites and creations, images greatly manipulated with a variety of filters, photos with artistic borders, photos stitched into a panoramic, etc.

## Food:

A still life specialization of photography, aimed at producing attractive photographs of food for use in such items of advertisements, packaging, menus and/or cookbooks.

Examples: Cakes/pies, Easter Eggs, fruits and place settings, ingredients, sandwiches, Thanksgiving dinner, etc.

**NOT ALLOWED:** A photo of alcohol beverages.

### **Landscape/Nature (Non-Animal):**

The focus of this category includes landscapes, outdoor scenics, nature images, sunsets, urban landscapes, seascapes, cityscapes, and farms. Images focus on the beauty of the outdoors.

Example: Gardens /Landscapes, Outdoors, Scenic, etc.

**NOT ALLOWED:** Primary subject is a person or wildlife.

#### **Leading Line:**

This image composition technique features lines that draw the viewer's eye from point A to point B, which is the primary subject.

Example: A river that begins in the foreground and draws your attention to a photogenic bridge in the background.

#### **Long Exposure:**

Also known as time-exposure or slow-shutter, this technique involves using a long-duration shutter speed. It can be used to sharply capture stationary elements of an image while blurring, smearing, or obscuring the moving elements. It is also used in low-light conditions.

Example: Fireworks, moving water, light trails, Milky Way, light painting, night or low-light conditions, etc.

#### **Motion/Action:**

The capture of movement within a single photo. The subject appears stopped or "frozen".

Example: Ferris Wheel Spinning, Sporting Events, Horse running across field, etc.

#### People:

Photos focus from all walks of life, parenting and family, children, babies, models/fashion, sports, and couples. All individuals in the photos must have provided consent and permission as a subject. If requested, a release will be needed from the photographer and subject.

Example: Babies, Families, Kids, Portraits, Models/Fashion, etc.

#### Plant/Flora:

Photos of interesting, unique, and beautiful flowers and flora. Photography can occur outdoors or indoors. Photography can occur outdoors or indoors. Photo subject should be that of a <u>single</u> flower, plant, bush, tree, etc. Large collections of plant/flora should be considered for entry into the Landscape/ Nature category.

Example: A rose, an upward shot of a tree, etc.

#### Shadow/Silhouette:

A silhouette is an outline that appears dark (typically a single color) with little or no details/features against a brighter background. Recording patterns of light and shade for a desired effect or emphasis is the definition of a shadow. The Silhouette or shadow must be the primary subject and focus of the image.

Example: Shadows/Silhouettes of people, plants, animals, structures, architectures, or natural structures.

**NOT ALLOWED: Reflections**
