

Further Description of Important Features (Continue on reverse if necessary) The principal section of this house is two stories, side-gabled with a brick chimney on the gable slope and built on a coursed limestone block foundation. The entrance is oriented away from the street and towards the driveway. Windows are 1/1, doors are paneled and glazed. Highlights include a bay window and door on the southern eave wall; an over-sized 1/1 window in the east gable end; turned columns supporting the shed-roofed porch; and "saw-tooth" millwork | |  | | 30. | 43. History and Significance The house was built by Daniel McGettigan c1902 on land he had purchased from his neighbor, John Hughes c1900 (ERI-1576). Daniel was the son of Barney and Margaret McGettigan (ERI-1757), one of the earliest settlers to purchase land from Datus and Irad Kelley. Born on the island in 1851, he worked with his brothers as a fisherman. He did not marry until 1898 when | | | | |
