## 1923 - 1995

Nora A. Wissner, 71 of Sebawaing, died Monday morning, March 13 at the Bay Shore Nursing Care Center in Bay City, following a brief illness.

She was born July 23, 1923 in Falmouth Township, daughter of the late Alfred E. and Amanda (Mintz) Lindeman.
