Arthur F. Carr, age 80, of 335 Pinnebog Rd., Bad Axe, passed away Thursday, March 11 at his home.

He was born April 6, 1901 in Colfax Township, son of the late William and Mary Ann Carr. On August 11, 1951 he was united in marriage to Violet O'Conner Weigand at Bad Axe. She preceded him in death on March 31, 1980.
