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ADULT REFRRALS TO UHCW MTC

Referrals should be made by a minimum of a Registrar level doctor and should be discussed first with the local ED Consultant. Please ensure you have the details available on the referral form (see last page) before you make contact:

PAEDIATRICS

Please note that UHCW is a NOT a Paediatric MTC. Within the CETN, children <16 years should be referred to Birmingham Children's Hospital via KIDS on 0300 200 1100.

IMAGING

Please ensure that all CT/x-rays have been linked via IEP before referral.

FUTILITY

Decision-making about futility is difficult and it may not be appropriate to transfer patients with no hope of survival away from their home and family. Please ensure you have assessed frailty before making a referral to support any discussion with the MTC Consultant.

TRANSFER

Arrange for an appropriate clinical escort. Ensure the patients notes, scan reports and adequate fluid resuscitation e.g. blood is ready to go with them.

Contact Ambulance Control via 999 to request an ambulance transfer. The local air ambulance critical care team (doctor and paramedic) may be available to support time-critical transfers to the MTC.

Please ask the ambulance crew to 'trauma alert' the patient when 20 minutes away from UHCW.

Call the UHCW resus phone when the patient has left your department on 02476 967125.
