- Student may use scholarship money at any accredited community/junior college or four-year college/university.
- Application **must** be accompanied by two (2) letters of recommendation.
- All applications must be completely filled out and PRINTED IN INK.
- An official transcript for grades 9-12 must be included with the application.
- * Selected applicants will be required to attend the June, 2020, Mid Valley Cowbelles membership meeting (to be held on the second Monday of the month) for introduction and recognition. <u>Approximate</u> meeting time will be 6:00pm.
- * Funds for the selected recipients will be distributed no later than <u>September 15th</u> of the awarding year upon proof of enrollment/admission. Documents must be received by both the Scholarship Chairman and MVC Treasurer by this date or the scholarship becomes <u>null and void</u>.
