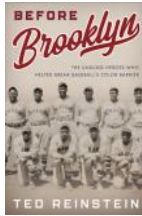
Before Brooklyn (with Ted Reinstein)

Join us to hear author Ted Reinstein talk about his latest book, *Before Brooklyn: The Unsung Heroes Who Helped Break Baseball's Color Barrier*. It's the inspiring story of ordinary, everyday Americans who did extraordinary things to overturn an historic injustice. They were men and women,

black and white. They were baseball players, journalists, Pullman porters, and political leaders, with a conscience. They paved the way for Jackie Robinson and achieved a landmark victory, but have remained largely unknown - until now!
