



St. Michael's Veterans Center is a campus on a 24-acre site located at East 39th Street and Emanuel Cleaver II Blvd., just south of the VA Medical Center in Kansas City, Missouri. This unique campus consists of 117 apartment homes that offer affordable, permanent housing, a Services Center, a planned Patriot Park and various recreational areas all together that address the needs of homeless or disabled military veterans.

Eligibility

- Must be a military veteran with a DD-214
- Must be homeless OR have a documented disability
- Income below \$28,000

- Monday – Friday from 9:00 a.m. – 3:00 p.m.
