2018-2019 School Year Tuition Assistance Discount For Parish/ Regional/Private Catholic Elementary Teachers

Beginning with the 1999-2000 school year, the Catholic School Department established a tuition assistance benefit for Catholic elementary school teachers whose children attend grades 9-12 at Holy Name Central Catholic High School, St. Bernard's Central Catholic High School, St. Mary's High School and St. Peter-Marian Central Catholic High School. These grants are funded by the Central Catholic and St. Mary's High Schools and is intended to recognize both the contribution and sacrifice of fellow diocesan professional educators. This benefit is subject to the following conditions:

- The tuition benefit for the 2018-2019 school year is \$1,500.00 per student. This grant will not affect any other tuition assistance that your daughter/son might receive (i.e. grant-in-aid, school scholarship, etc.) since it will be applied after that assistance has been awarded.
- The tuition benefit is not available for grades 7-8 at Holy Name Central Catholic Jr/Sr High School, St. Mary Jr/Sr High School and St. Peter-Marian Central Catholic Jr/Sr High School.
- The tuition benefit is available to individuals who are classified as full-time teachers or administrators (does not apply to teachers' aides, secretarial or maintenance staff) in Diocesan elementary schools and, who have completed one (1) year of service in one of our elementary schools.
- Teachers must notify their principals in writing, on or before Wednesday, February 28, 2018 of any children who will be attending grades 9-12 in one of the above-mentioned schools in order to receive credit on their child's tuition account. The tuition benefit will also be granted to new students enrolled on or after March 1, 2018 but no later than Friday, June 29, 2018. The Principal will then send the necessary information to the Catholic Schools Office, to the attention of Susan M. Saucier, at the Student Account Office.
- Full-time teachers at Mercy Centre for Developmental Disabilities, McAuley-Nazareth Home for Boys and parish Directors of Religious Education who have been certified by the Office of Religious Education are also eligible for the tuition benefit according to the same terms listed above.
- This benefit does not apply to part time, teacher's aides, secretarial, maintenance staffs etc. that are employed by the school.
