**Public Relations Team** introduces VIPs and hunters to reporters.

**Photography Team** sets up outdoor studio and computer equipment.

Marine Corps Band & Color Guard arrive.

**11 am** Volunteers and civilian hunters line the avenue of live oaks waving flags to welcome the Wounded Warriors.

**Welcome Team** distributes gift bags, flags and name tag holders to Wounded Warriors.

Wounded Warriors sign liability release and model release forms.

**Welcome Team** introduces Wounded Warrior to their guides & Landowner hosts.

**11:15 – 11:45am** Parris Island Marine Corps Band performance.

**12:00 noon** Invocation and National Anthem.

**12:15 pm** Welcome and opening remarks. (Speakers to be announced).

- 2:30 pm** Hunters & volunteers leave for afternoon hunt.

- 7:00 – 9:00 pm** Hunters return from afternoon hunt. Brunswick Stew and cornbread available at Nemours Plantation for hunters and volunteers.
- Deer Processing Team** cleans deer at Nemours and other plantations.
- Hunters go to Marine Corps Air Station or local motels.

**Tuesday, October 28<sup>th</sup>, 2014**

- 5 am** Hunters & volunteers meet at prearranged locations and go to their hunting locations for morning hunt.
- 11 am** Hunters and volunteers return to Nemours Plantation
- 12 noon** Frogmore Stew lunch is served by volunteer **Ben Moise**.
- 2 pm** **Deer Processing Team** prepares meat for hunters to take home. Coolers of frozen venison are distributed to hunters.
- Clean-up Team** polices Nemours Plantation grounds puts away furniture, cleans the kitchen, mops floors and empties garbage cans.
- Tents, tables and chairs are taken down and returned to MCCC by USMC volunteers.
