Special Town Meeting: Monhegan Plantation held a special town meeting to vote to see if the plantation will authorize the assessors to create an advisory committee to aid in developing a community benefits agreement with Maine Aqua Ventus. The vote passed. Also to authorize the assessors to expend up to \$10,000.00 from the Emily T. Farrell fund to hire professionals to aid the plantation in negotiating said agreement. This vote passed.

Fire Barn: Roof still in need of repair.

Vote to transfer \$10,000.00 from Emily T. Farrell fund to Monhegan Plantation checking acct. was passed.

Move to create a dedicated acct. called: M.A.V. Advisory Committee Acct. to accept \$10,000.00 from Monhegan Plantation Checking Acct. (pathed from Emily T. Farrell fund)
