First Lesson Jeremiah 26:12-16 [12](#) Then Jeremiah spoke to all the officials and all the people, saying, "The LORD sent me to prophesy against this house and this city all the words you have heard." [13](#) Now therefore mend your ways and your deeds, and obey the voice of the LORD your God, and the LORD will relent of the disaster that he has pronounced against you. [14](#) But as for me, behold, I am in your hands. Do with me as seems good and right to you. [15](#) Only know for certain that if you put me to death, you will bring innocent blood upon yourselves and upon this city and its inhabitants, for in truth the LORD sent me to you to speak all these words in your ears." [16](#) Then the officials and all the people said to the priests and the prophets, "This man does not deserve the sentence of death, for he has spoken to us in the name of the LORD our God."

Second Lesson Philippians 3:17-4:1 [17](#) Brothers, join in imitating me, and keep your eyes on those who walk according to the example you have in us. [18](#) For many, of whom I have often told you and now tell you even with tears, walk as enemies of the cross of Christ. [19](#) Their end is destruction, their god is their belly, and they glory in their shame, with minds set on earthly things. [20](#) But our citizenship is in heaven, and from it we await a Savior, the Lord Jesus Christ, [21](#) who will transform our lowly body to be like his glorious body, by the power that enables him even to subject all things to himself. [1](#) Therefore, my brothers, whom I love and long for, my joy and crown, stand firm thus in the Lord, my beloved.

Gospel Luke 13:22-30 [22](#) He went on his way through towns and villages, teaching and journeying toward Jerusalem. [23](#) And someone said to him, "Lord, will those who are saved be few?" And he said to them [24](#) "Strive to enter through the narrow door. For many, I tell you, will seek to enter and will not be able. [25](#) When once the master of the house has risen and shut the door, and you begin to stand outside and to knock at the door, saying, 'Lord, open to us,' then he will answer you, 'I do not know where you come from.' [26](#) Then you will begin to say, 'We ate and drank in your presence, and you taught in our streets.' [27](#) But he will say, 'I tell you, I do not know where you come from. Depart from me, all you workers of evil!' [28](#) In that place there will be weeping and gnashing of teeth, when you see Abraham and Isaac and Jacob and all the prophets in the kingdom of God but you yourselves cast out. [29](#) And people will come from east and west, and from north and south, and recline at table in the kingdom of God. [30](#) And behold, some are last who will be first, and some are first who will be last."
