



## Recovery Housing Residency Criteria:

Stop the Heroin Recovery Homes are dedicated to providing a positive environment where recovery can take place. We desire to provide a safe environment where you can make the changes necessary for a transition into productive living.

We are not a drug or alcohol treatment facility nor do we claim to be experts or professionals on the medical, psychological, or physiological aspects of addiction. We are simply a family of recovering men that believe in the therapeutic value of one addict helping another is without parallel.

## Basic Criteria:

1. Stop the Heroin Recovery Homes are women and men's homes.
2. Residents must be active in a recovery program.
3. Rent is \$160/wk and a move in fee of \$620 (security deposit, admin fee, first 2 weeks rent) is due upon move in. Rent is due each Sunday by 6:30pm. Late rent is not permitted.
4. We believe in a productive environment, and residents are expected to be gainfully and legally employed. People who receive funds from legal sources other than employment (disability, family, etc) are required to volunteer 10 to 20 hours per week (determined on an individual basis).
5. There is an absolute zero tolerance for alcohol or drugs. Narcotic pain medications are not permitted, including including, but not limited to: codeine, fentanyl (Actiq, Duragesic, Fentora), hydrocodone (Hysingla ER, Zohydro ER), hydrocodone/acetaminophen (Lorcet, Lortab, Norco, Vicodin), hydromorphone (Dilaudid, Exalgo), meperidine (Demerol), methadone (Dolophine, Methadose) and Gabapentin. DRTs (drug replacement therapy) is not permitted. Naltrexone (Vivitrol) is accepted when prescribed by a doctor.
6. We do run a criminal background check. Whereas we realize you may have a criminal record, we expect you to be open and honest about your offenses and current legal situation. An individual determination may be made based on the frequency, severity, and timeliness of offenses. We will be more open to working with you if you are honest and upfront with anything we may find.
