use to conserve water. Various types of restrictiions and WATER USE
metering pumps was discussed. Dutch suggested some of the
pumps above the Corbin Well might also be available. Dale
reported it was costing about \$7,000 to connect the Corbin
well. George suggested the District pay the pumping costs
until the lake runs dry, then if people want to buy water,
they can pay the pumping costs. Everyone must have to have
the same percentage of restrictions. Dutch moved the Board
take the following action:

1: Start all the pumps possible and pay 65% of
pumping costs as long as there is water in the lake;

2: Get the meters in and read as soon as possible
and limit all use to 65%;

3: When the lake runs dry, the pumps go off un-
less the users pay the pumping costs;

4: Adjust the restriction rate monthly on the
15th of each month.

Jim Walker seconded. MOTION CARRIED.


Dale reported the pressure switch will be in on
Monday, and he will put the Corbin well on line.


Pumping the river to the 5th West Moab Irrigation POSSIBLE PUMPIN
