- As a condition of entry, we ask member who sell work online to agree to donate 10% of the sales to the Hunger Task Force of SE Wisconsin. Think of this as an altruistic commission!
- Each member may enter **5** images. These images **may not** be exhibited again in future WPA shows. NFS work is allowed. Nudes are ok. *Titles and prices may not be changed once the work is submitted.*

We are will hold a Zoom Opening Reception, beginning at 7 PM on May 25, Memorial Day. Our judge will announce awards and provide comments at 7:10 PM.

Checks will be mailed and all ribbons will be awarded at our next (physical) Membership meeting.

Your Responsibilities

- No framing!
- Submit your **well-lit and appropriately cropped** images (If your piece is framed-please don't photograph through the glass-remove it for shooting) to Karen Wick (kjwick1@yahoo.com) or Judy Grochowski (jgrochowski@wi.rr.com) in an email with **Submission** on the subject line
- Before emailing, **save the photo** as the **title** of the painting (*please do **this** step!! And if you are uncertain, ask*)
- For our website, the **size** of your image files needs to be **72 dpi** (photos taken by smart phones work well)
- **Additional (email) information needed:** Title (again), size of piece framed or unframed, price or NFS. You will need to resubmit if photos are not readable, cropped appropriately, info missing. Plan to enter in a timely fashion, in case issues arise.
- Karen and Judy will forward images ready to be uploaded to Julia
- If your painting is purchased, it is your responsibility to follow up with the buyer
