

WILLIAM EDWARD McBRIDE

1960 - 1996

William E. "Bill" McBride, 35 of Elkton, died at his home on Friday, June 28, 1996. He was born Aug. 30, 1960 at Scheurer Hospital, Pigeon. He was the oldest son of Anna Jean McBride and the late John C. McBride.

Bill was a 1977 graduate of Laker High. Immediately following high school, he joined the U.S. Navy serving three years of active duty and three years in the reserves. On his return to Elkton he took a position at Huron Casting, Inc., almost 15 years ago, where he was currently in the heat treating department.

He was a very active member of the Oliver Twp. Fire Dept., Elkton Lions Club and attended St. Felix Catholic Church, Pinnebog.

Surviving are his mother Jean McBride of Elkton; two brothers, John (Julie) McBride of Minden City and Tom McBride of Skyler, NB; three sisters, Mary (Frank) Kampa of Almont, Linda (Gary) Luttmann of Pigeon and Joann (Greg) Bailey of Bad Axe and special friend Dana Young of Elkton. Also surviving are three nieces and four nephews.

His father preceded him in death Feb. 24, 1987.

A funeral mass will be conducted at 11 a.m. Tuesday, July 2, at St. Felix Catholic Church, Pinnebog. Sr. Mary Schwartz, pastor will officiate, with burial and Elkton VFW graveside honors in the church cemetery.
