Holy Scripture

OLD TESTAMENT READING - Psalm 68.1-6,32-35

Let God rise up, let His enemies be scattered; let those who hate Him flee before Him. As smoke is driven away, so drive them away; as wax melts before the fire, let the wicked perish before God but let the righteous be joyful; let them exult before God; let them be jubilant with joy. Sing to God, sing praises to His name; lift up a song to Him who rides upon the clouds - His name is the LORD - be exultant before Him. Father of orphans and protector of widows is God in His holy habitation. God gives the desolate a home to live in; He leads out the prisoners to prosperity, but the rebellious live in a parched land. Sing to God, O kingdoms of the Earth; sing praises to the Lord! O rider in the Heavens, the ancient heavens; listen, He sends out His voice, His mighty voice. Ascribe power to God, whose majesty is over Israel and whose power is in the skies. Awesome is God in His sanctuary, the God of Israel; He gives power and strength to His people. Blessed be God!

GOSPEL LESSON - Luke 15.11-24

Then Jesus said, "There was a man who had two sons. The younger of them said to his father, 'Father, give me the share of the property that will belong to me.' So [the father] divided his property between them. A few days later the younger son gathered all he had and traveled to a distant country, and there he squandered his property in dissolute living. When he had spent everything, a severe famine took place throughout that country and he began to be in need. So he went and hired himself out to one of the citizens of that country, who sent [the younger son] to his fields to feed the pigs. [The young man] would gladly have filled himself with the pods that the pigs were eating [but] no one gave him anything. When he came to himself he said, 'How many of my father's hired hands have bread enough and to spare, but here I am dying of hunger! I will get up and go to my father, and I will say to him, "Father, I have sinned against Heaven and before you; I am no longer worthy to be called your son; treat me like one of your hired hands."'" So he set off and went to his father. But while he was still far off, his father saw him and was filled with compassion; [his father] ran and put his arms around [his younger son] and kissed him. Then the son said to him, 'Father, I have sinned against Heaven and before you; I am no longer worthy to be called your son.' But the father said to his slaves, 'Quickly, bring out a robe - the best one - and put it on him; put a ring on his finger and sandals on his feet and get the fatted calf and kill it and let us eat and celebrate; for this dead son of mine is alive again; he was lost and is found!' and they began to celebrate.
