DESCRIPTION: RARE re-conditioned 1969 Type I Bear Kodiak Magnum. The '69 Type One featured a Tigerwood riser, Artic Gray limbs, black tip overlays, and black on white back riser overlays. Great looking and performing recurve. Bow has no delamination; no cracks; limbs are straight. Overlays and tips are in great condition. No drilled holes; No chips, dings or cracks. No crazing or stress cracks. There was one long scratch (not a stress crack) in the lower back limb that was filled (see pic on last page. The close-up of the limb gave it a bluish tint but it is gray like the other limb pics). A few minor scratches and nicks here and there. Decals are in fair condition. A previous owner had painted the bow a dark gray, and you can see the residual of that around the decals. The rest of the paint was removed and the bow re-conditioned. This bow was put to a stress test (held at full draw for 16 hours) to make sure the old glues held and no stress cracks developed. It was then tested and shot several times. Comes with a new string.
