

Firewood permits allow you to cut no more than 10 cords per year of firewood on the Iron County Forest. Only wood that is lying on the ground is allowed to be cut. NO STANDING TREES WHETHER DEAD OR ALIVE or decked wood is allowed to be harvested.

Beginning May 1, 2015, Firewood Permits will cost \$20 and expire one (1) year from the date issued. They can be obtained in person at the Forestry Department Office, at the WDNR Mercer Ranger Station, or by mail with a written request and the \$20 permit fee.
