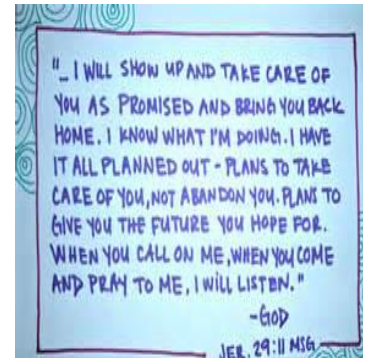

PW NOTES



Presbyterian Women adopted its 2018 budget in January. The budget includes \$4,200 in mission spending for the year. Another \$2,100 is dedicated to church events for a total budget of \$6,300. Keep an eye out for this PW symbol from month to month as we share with you how our mission dollars work.

Campus Kitchen at W&L receives \$300 for its backpack program. With a budget of \$32,000, CK fills backpacks with food to send home with children whose only regular access to food is at school. Here are the numbers of packs being filled this school year. Rivermont (alternative education at former Rockbridge Middle): 31, Waddell: 22, Mountain View: 40, Natural Bridge: 128, Enderly Head Start: 30, Waddell Head Start: 19, BV Head Start: 30, Fairfield: 95, Kling: 62, Enderly: 70, Maury River: 47, Lylburn Downing: 8. Manly Memorial Baptist packs the 92 bags distributed at Central.
