CAP Money Course



The CAP Money Course, designed by Christians Against Poverty, is aimed at helping you manage your finances. Crewkerne Baptist Church will be running the course at Wadham School on Wednesday evenings during November (6th, 13th and 20th) starting at 6.30pm.
