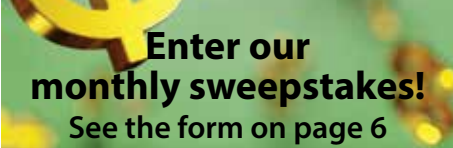

An epic royal streak

The hope of all video poker players is to hit a royal flush. Sometimes it takes weeks, even months or years before you hit one; other times, you might just get lucky and hit one or two right quick. Think that's impossible? Read on because I'm going to share with you a remarkable streak of royal flushes that happened to me. (I'm doing this not to gloat or boast about my good fortune but rather to show you it can happen even with long odds.)

My streak began when I hit two royal flushes on two consecutive trips playing 9/6 Jacks or Better. This was certainly exciting but it's nothing compared to what happened next.

My wife and I went to Las Vegas for a two-week vacation and during this time I hit three more royal flushes and she hit two. When we returned home, I proceeded to hit six more royal flushes over the course of one month. Final tally was 11 royal flushes over a period of about two months.

Several of the royal flushes were memorable. In one session, I was dealt a royal. (The odds of this happening are 1 in 649,740). On three consecutive playing sessions, I was dealt only one four-card royal flush over roughly six hours of play. Each time I hit the draw button I got the card I needed for a royal flush. In one stretch, I hit four royal flushes in each of four consecutive trips to the same casino. (I wound up with seven royals in eight consecutive playing sessions.)

It certainly takes a bit of luck to get a royal streak like mine but it's also important that you know the right playing strategies. For example, in one of my hands I was dealt a high pair along with a four-card royal



flush. Many players would hold the paying high pair rather than hold the four cards to the royal. That's a costly mistake; in the long run, you'll earn more money by holding the four cards to the royal (yes, most times you won't draw the card you need for the royal but it only has to happen once to more than make up for the losses). Needless to say, I made the correct play, held the four cards to the royal and got the card I needed on the draw for a royal flush.

In another hand, I was dealt a three-card straight flush that contained one gap along with two cards to the royal flush. Most players when confronted with this hand would hold the three cards to the straight flush; however, that is another mistake. The correct play is to hold the two suited high cards (i.e., two cards to the royal) over the three cards to the straight flush with gaps. (This is what I did and, fortunately, got the three cards I needed on the draw for a royal flush.)

Do you get my point about the

importance of knowing the playing strategy? If I didn't play the above two hands correctly, I would have missed out on two potential royal flushes during my streak.

Sometimes, even using perfect playing strategy, you can go hand after hand without getting a royal flush. I know this can be frustrating. However, if you continue to practice the playing strategies at home on your computer so that you can play every hand perfectly in a casino, take along a strategy card when you do play just in case, and have enough bankroll to weather those inevitable royal flush droughts, you'll still be in the game when the royals finally come. Just don't abandon the ship—stay the course by playing only games that return over 99.5% with perfect playing strategy, have enough playing bankroll, and take advantage of casino promotions to increase your cashback and bounce back, and in the long run you'll do just fine.

Gaming News

U.S. Gaming Revenue sets record

The U.S. commercial (non-tribal) gaming industry hit a record high for gross gaming revenue (GGR) in calendar-year 2025, generating \$78.7 billion, a 9.2% increase over 2024's total, according to the American Gaming Association's Commercial Gaming Revenue Tracker. Casino games earned \$50.9 billion, up 2.3%, sports betting won a hair under \$17 billion on a total handle of \$167 billion (a hold of 11%), and igaming hit \$10.7 billion, a 22.8% increase year over year. All told, casinos, sports books, and online gambling paid \$18.1 billion in taxes. Tribal casinos, meanwhile, generated their own record in GGR, \$43.9 billion, for fiscal year 2024 (reported in July

2025), marking a 4.6% increase over the previous fiscal year. This revenue, derived from 532 gaming operations in 29 states, was the fourth consecutive year of record-breaking performance. Gambling in the U.S. is a \$125 billion or so industry.

Las Vegas bets on Canada

The Las Vegas Convention and Visitors Authority board of directors will consider a contract worth up to \$6 million over five years to fund targeted marketing in Canada. The move comes after one of the worst years for Canadian visitation in the city's modern history. The importance of Canadian visitors to Las Vegas cannot be overstated. In 2025, the destination had nearly 1.2 million visitors from Canada, which accounts for 25% of all international visitors to the Las Vegas destination. Canada has been one of the top two countries

sending international visitors to Las Vegas since 2000. The LVCVA estimated that while the total number of visitors to Vegas between January and November 2025 dropped 7.4% year over year, visitors from Canada fell by around 24%. The drop in Canadian visitors is not primarily due to pricing. It is a political one. In a Longwoods International tracking study from August 2025, 63% of Canadian travelers said they were less likely to visit the United States, citing politics as a reason. Among those who said U.S. policy affects their travel choices, 80% noted that tariffs were key deterrents, and 71% said they were put off by political statements by American leaders. President Trump's tariffs on Canadian goods and his repeated suggestion that Canada could become the 51st U.S. state triggered a widespread sentiment shift.

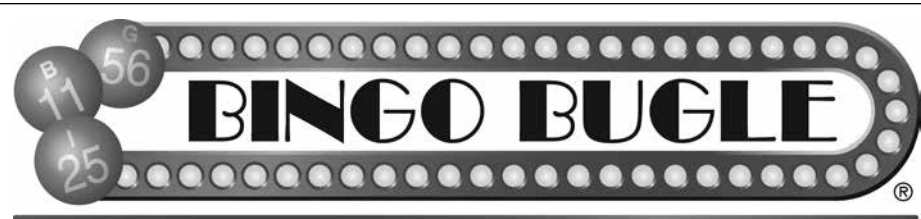

Participation tips

We recently asked Google's Large Language Model (also known as AI) for ways to increase participation in charity bingo, and here, edited, were some of the suggestions, culled from a wide variety of sources. Players should feel free to share tips they find relevant with their hall managers, and if anyone has more to add to this list, please feel free to email your suggestions to Bingo Bugle's national editor at tara@bingobugle.com.

1. Adopt Electronic Equipment. Explore the idea of adding electronic bingo handhelds that allow players to manage multiple cards simultaneously, increasing game speed and engagement.

2. Introduce Thematic Nights. Move beyond standard bingo with themes like Designer Purse Bingo, 1980s Retro, or Beach Party to attract specific demographics.

3. Leverage Secondary Income Sources. Offer high-quality food and drink at reasonable prices. Include side activities like raffles, pull-tabs, or bonus games between main rounds.

4. Corporate Sponsorships. Partner with local businesses for in-kind donations of prizes or refreshments in exchange for advertising space at the event.

Bingo hall closing

The West St. Paul Bingo Palace, located at 1361 S. Robert St, closed permanently in April 2026. Their final day of operation was Saturday, April 18, 2026. The landlord of the Southview Shopping Center location did not renew the lease, forcing the closure. The Bingo Palace had previously closed in November 2023, only to reopen five months later in April 2024 with support from the local chapter of AMVETS. AMVETS Post 1, the operators, had explored moving the bingo hall to a former Family Dollar space nearby in South St. Paul. However, according to reports from the West St. Paul Reader, this deal did not materialize, leading the board to opt for a permanent shutdown. The venue was a significant community hub for many, particularly for local veterans and seniors, and its closure has been met with disappointment and sadness from longtime patrons and staff. Should another facility location in the West St. Paul vicinity materialize, The Bingo Bugle will report the information to its readers as soon as possible.

5. Dynamic Ticket Pricing: Offer early-bird discounts or VIP group packages to secure attendance and cover upfront costs early.

6. Ensure Legal and Operational Stability.

-Avoid costly fines or shutdowns by adhering to regional gaming laws.

- Keep meticulous daily records of gross receipts and payouts, as required by state gaming commissions.

-Protect your event with the proper insurance to cover financial risks related to accidents or property damage.

7. Community Promotion. Consistent and varied marketing is essential for recurring attendance. Use all free social media, and the Bingo Bugle print and online, to promote your event. The Bingo Bugle is the only coast to coast newspaper dedicated to the promotion of charity bingo and all other kinds of gambling games. Create a dedicated event hashtag and post behind-the-scenes content to build momentum. Ask board members and sponsors to share event details on their personal networks to reach new audiences. Post flyers in high-traffic local spots like coffee shops, community centers and senior centers

Thefts of taxpayer money

Note to thieves: Don't get stopped on a traffic violation while you're carrying stolen goods and electronics in your car. One pathetic criminal was stopped while transporting electronics that were bought by an in-house thief at the VA who was in charge of buying goods with government credit cards.

The VA thief had handed over part of his \$200,000 stash of stolen electronics to have them sold by his thief partner. Found in the traffic stop were phones, a gun with a magazine, stolen credit cards and a pile of cash. At the VA thief's home additional electronic items were found.

Unfortunately, these thieves will only serve a year in prison, but they do have to pay back nearly \$200,000.

The VA's Office of Inspector General (along with the IRS and the SBA) was in on the investigation of a thief who stole \$1 million in CARES Act funds — and bought himself a 9-hole golf course. The Coronavirus Aid, Relief and Economic Security money was to help small businesses stay afloat through the Covid pandemic, a loan to be used for payroll, rent, mortgage and other business expenses.

The thief owned four companies at the time and applied for economic injury money on all of them because he wasn't able to get a standard bank loan for the golf course purchase. When applying for the money, he neglected to mention that one of the companies was being sold to someone else at the time.

He could have gotten up to 20 years in prison and a fine of \$250,000. Instead, he was sentenced to only 15 months in prison and a year of supervised release — after fraudulently obtaining over a million dollars of taxpayer money.

Perhaps taxpayers will get the money back: The golf course is currently for sale.

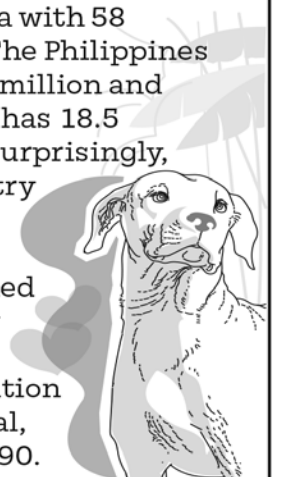
Bingo. If they weren't willing to do so, many Bingo games would cease to exist.

Top ten casino mistakes

Here are ten of the most common mistakes players make in a casino. See how many you make. Then follow the simple steps on how to avoid them. The fewer mistakes you make in a casino the more fun and excitement you'll get out of your casino-going experience.

#1. Going into a casino with the idea of making money. Steve Wynn, business magnate, said, "The only way to make money in a casino is to own one." Think of the casino as a place to get away and have some fun, with winning just a bonus.

#2. Taking a checkbook and credit cards to the casino. Play only with the money you bring to a casino. Take just one credit card and use it for out-of-pocket expenses only: meals, shows, shopping, trip expenses, etc. Keep away from the ubiquitous casino ATMs. Playing with plastic will come back to haunt you when the bank statements start coming in.

#3. Playing with money you don't have. If you run out of money, stop playing. Go home or do something different until it's time to leave.

#4. Forgetting you're playing with real money. Casinos encourage you to play with tokens, credits, tickets, etc. When you do, you forget you're playing with real money and you tend to play faster and make bigger bets and foolish bets.

#5. Having little or no knowledge of the game you're playing. Learn all you can about your favorite game. The

more you know about it, the better playing experience you're going to have. So, check with your local bookstore, library, Amazon.com, or casino gift shop for a how-to book on your favorite game.

#6. Continuing to play when losing. The instant you feel you're on a losing streak, set a firm quit point. When you reach it, quit! Don't keep thinking the next spin of the reels or throw of the dice is going to do it. Odds are, it won't. When you're in a hole, stop digging!

#7. Playing off all winnings. Set aside some of each slot machine win—no matter how small. Hit the cash-out button and put the ticket in your pocket. Decide later what to do with it.

#8. Not joining the casino's players club. The points you earn for playing makes you eligible for cash-back awards, free or discounted rooms, free meals and show tickets, and other freemiums.

#9. Playing more than one slot machine at a time. By playing multiple slots you bet more and lose faster. You also become a target for casino ticket snatchers who look for slot players playing more than one machine.

#10. Not knowing when to quit. Deciding when to quit playing is the most difficult decision to make in a casino. As long as you have money and are having fun, keep playing. But stop when your luck runs out or when tired, upset, bored, or sleepy. When playing stops being fun, stop playing.

Easy sausage appetizers

Dear Annie,

My hubby loves sausage. Do you have any recipes for an easy appetizer I can make with sausage? Thanks. — Deborah from Dallas, Texas

Dear Deborah,

Here are two fairly easy sausage recipes. "Sausage Balls" and "Pinwheels" are two of my favorite recipes. Enjoy. —Annie

SAUSAGE BALLS

- 3 cups buttermilk baking mix
- 1 pound pork sausage
- 4 cups shredded Cheddar cheese
- 1/2 teaspoon dried rosemary
- 1/2 teaspoon dried parsley flakes

Combine all the ingredients in mixer bowl. Beat at a low speed until well mixed, scraping the bowl frequently. Shape into 1-inch balls. Place on an ungreased 10-by-15-inch baking pan. Bake at 350 degrees for 20 to 25

minutes or until brown. Remove from the pan immediately; drain.

PINWHEELS

- 1 8-ounce can crescent rolls
- 2 tablespoons melted butter
- 1/4 cup Parmesan cheese
- 1-2 teaspoons oregano
- 8 brown and serve sausage links

Separate dough into four rectangles. Press perforations to seal. Brush each piece with butter. Combine the cheese and oregano and sprinkle over the dough. Cut crosswise and form into squares. Roll up the sausage in the dough. Cut each roll into four pieces. Secure with a toothpick. Bake at 475 degrees for 15 to 20 minutes.

Medicare can help smokers kick the habit

Dear Savvy Senior,

Does Medicare offer any coverage that helps beneficiaries quit smoking? — **New Beneficiary**

Dear New,

If you’re ready to quit smoking, Medicare can indeed help! Medicare Part B covers up to eight face-to-face counseling sessions per year to help you kick the habit, and if you have a Medicare Part D prescription drug plan, certain smoking-cessation medications are covered as well. Here’s a guide to help you get started.

It’s Never Too Late

According to the Center of Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) 8.3 percent of Americans age 65 and older still smoke. Many older smokers indicate that they would like to quit, but because of the nicotine, which is extremely addictive, it’s very difficult to do.

Tobacco use is the leading cause of preventable illness, responsible for an estimated one-fifth of deaths in the United States each year. But research shows that quitting, even after age 65, greatly reduces your risk of heart disease, stroke, cancer, osteoporosis and many other diseases. It also helps you breathe easier, smell, and taste better, and can save you money. An \$8 pack-a-day smoker, for example, saves about \$240 after one month without cigarettes, and nearly \$2,880 after one year.

How to Quit

The first step you need to take is to set a “quit date,” but give yourself a few weeks to get ready. During that time, you may want to start by reducing the number or the strength of cigarettes you smoke to begin weaning yourself.

Also check out over-the-counter nicotine replacement products — patches, gum and lozenges — to help curb your cravings (these are not covered by Medicare). And just prior to your quit day get rid of all cigarettes and ashtrays in your home, car, and place of work, and try to clean up and even spray air freshener. The smell of smoke can be a powerful trigger.

Get Help

Studies have shown that you have a much better chance of quitting if you have help. So, tell your friends, family, and coworkers of your plan to quit. Others knowing can be a helpful reminder and motivator.

Then get some counseling. Don’t go it alone. Start by contacting your doctor about smoking cessation counseling covered by Medicare and find out about the prescription antismoking drugs (bupropion and varenicline) that can help reduce your nicotine craving.

You can also get free one-on-one telephone counseling and referrals to local smoking cessation programs through your state quit line at 800-QUIT-NOW or call the National Cancer Institute free smoking quit line at 877-44U-QUIT.

It’s also important to identify and write down the times and situations you’re most likely to smoke and make a list of things you can do to replace it or distract yourself. Some helpful suggestions when the smoking urge arises are to call a friend or one of the free quit lines, keep your mouth occupied with some sugar-free gum, sunflower seeds, carrots, fruit or hard candy, go for a walk, read a magazine, listen to music or take a hot bath.

The intense urge to smoke lasts about three to five minutes, so do what you can to wait it out. It’s also wise to avoid drinking alcohol and steer clear of other smokers while you’re trying to quit. Both can trigger powerful urges to smoke.

Cooler hand breaks a player's heart

One of the most prestigious poker tournaments in the world is the \$50,000 buy-in Poker Players Championship, held annually at the World Series of Poker (WSOP) in Las Vegas.

The event, which dates back to 2006, is the highest-stakes mixed-games event. Some of the biggest names in poker have won the tournament including the inaugural winner, the late David "Chip" Reese, for whom the championship trophy is named. Other winners include Scotty Nguyen, Daniel Negreanu, two-time winner Dan Cates, three-time winner Brian Rast, and Michael "The Grinder" Mizrachi, who won the tournament for a record fourth time at the 2025 WSOP for \$1,331,322.

It was during the most recent iteration that a truly remarkable hand took place on Day 4.

The 107-entry field had been reduced to the final 11 players in Level 20 in a round of pot-limit Omaha (PLO). That is a game where each player receives four hole cards (as opposed to two in no-limit Texas hold'em) and must use two from their hand and three from the five community cards (the flop, turn, and river just like in hold'em) to make their best five-card hand.

Poker pro Erick Lindgren raised the button holding the As4sKc9d and Portugal's Joao Vieira defended from

the big blind with the Js9s8s2c. The Ah7s5d flop saw both players check, and then the dealer burned and turned the 6s.

Vieira turned the nut straight and bet 150,000, which Lindgren called holding top pair and an ace-high flush draw. The 10s river completed the flush draw, but it was bad news for Lindgren as Vieira had rived a straight flush!

With so much money on the line, not to mention the prestigious title, it looked like disaster was inevitable. Vieira bet again, this time 245,000, and Lindgren paused for a few beats before raising to 750,000, which left him a little over 400,000 behind. Vieira took his time before announcing that he was all in, and that left Lindgren shaking his head and asking, "For real?"

With an ace-high flush, the only hand that beat Lindgren's was exactly the 9s8s for a straight flush. Could Vieira really have it? Perhaps the better question was, would Vieira really move all in with a worse hand? Even if he had a king-high spade flush, it's unlikely he'd jam after Lindgren had raised.

There's no doubt it was a tough spot, and some critics think Lindgren should've folded and preserved what few chips he had left. However, he did call off his remaining stack, perhaps thinking there was a chance that Vieira either did shove with a king-high flush or was perhaps bluffing holding a straight flush blocker (i.e. he had only the 9s or 8s and thought he could represent a straight flush). Of course, we know that Vieira actually had the goods, so Lindgren's crying call was in vain.

Lindgren was eliminated in 11th place for \$121,573, while Vieira went on to finish in fifth place for \$298,614.

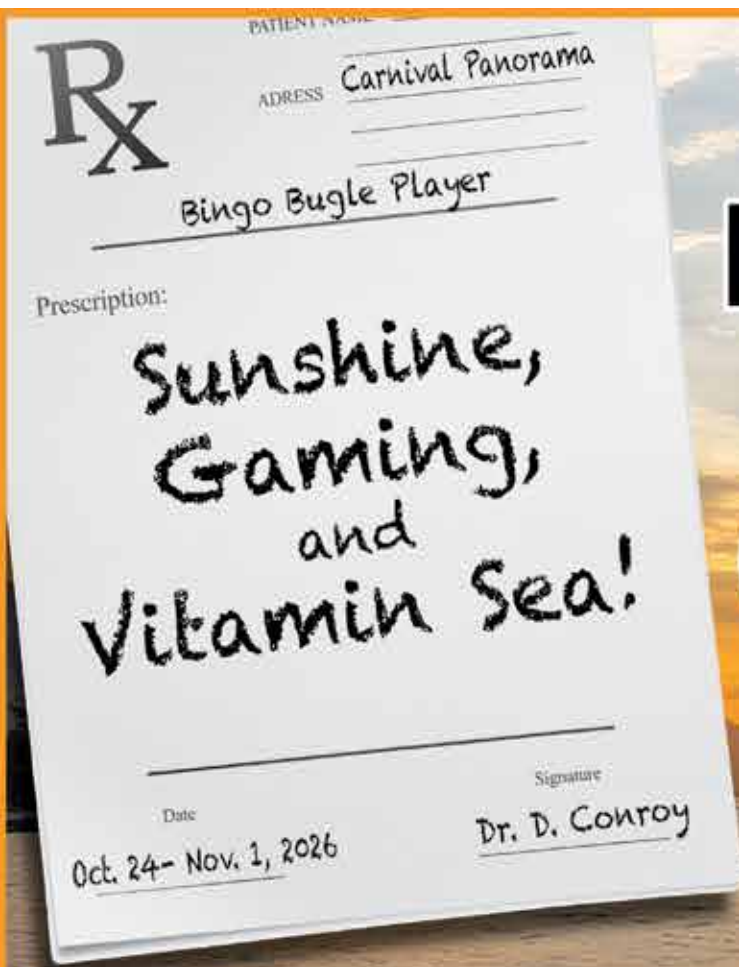
