“The World Gone Crazy”

“...in the image of God he created him; male and female he created them.” Genesis 1:27

Some of the most destructive ideas in our modern era have come from Europe. Beginning in the 1700s, German scholars began to argue that the Bible is just a human book. Karl Marx was a German who hung out in London and wrote up his ideas about Communism. The Netherlands and Belgium took a lead in promoting laws in support of euthanasia. European countries were the first to legalize gay marriage. In 2010 the Council of Europe came out against gender identity discrimination.

These ideas tend to make their way to the US. Sometimes they stop in Canada along the way. We Christians are obligated to love everyone. But these transgender ideas are harming our kids.

Robert Hoogland was arrested last week in Vancouver, British Columbia, for speaking out publicly about how his daughter’s public school has been dealing with his daughter. The father discovered that the middle school had been promoting gender identity education. In seventh grade he discovered that her yearbook showed her being referred to by a different name, as the school counselor changed her name without informing her parents. The school decided to do this on its own, without parental consent, after having received input from a psychologist who is supportive of gender transitioning.

Hoogland’s ex-wife has been persuaded to go along with the “gender-affirming” medical care. The school psychologist advised Hoogland’s daughter to take testosterone and referred her to an endocrinology unit at a nearby hospital. When Hoogland contested the matter in court, the judge ruled that the father’s consent was not relevant and that if he did not affirm his daughter as a male he would be implicated in the criminal offense of “family violence.”

“I had a perfectly healthy child a year ago, and that perfectly healthy child has been altered and destroyed for absolutely no good reason. She can never go back to being a girl in the healthy body that she should have had. She’s going to forever have a lower voice. She’ll forever have to shave because of facial hair. She won’t be able to have children...” At last report Hoogland is still in jail. (*The Christian Post*, 3/22/2021)

These are the takeaways from the story. We need to pray for the direction of our country. We need to tune in to what is being taught in our schools. We need to be aware of how our political representatives, including school members view these issues. We need to oppose The Equality Act, which has passed the US House of Representatives. - Pastor Kurt

Bethany's 2021 budget was based on receiving offerings averaging \$24,349.08 each month.


Year to date budget requirement was \$73,047.24. Year to date giving, through March, totaled approx \$69,423.55. The difference is (\$3,623.69).
