Camp Arrah Wanna's AWSOM Program exists to provide young adults (18-25) an opportunity to gain real-world leadership experience while also creating an environment that grows their faith and ability to live in Christian community.

Applicants should be seeking to honor God in every area of their lives, striving to live out the fruit of the Spirit and desiring to participate in this ministry with the heart of a servant, with a teachable spirit, a willingness to learn new things and be adaptable so as to re-learn old skills, habits, or traits when necessary. Life at Camp is busy and does

have stressful moments: Maintaining a positive attitude even with long work days, early mornings, and hot weather will go a long ways! Participation in activities, adventures, conversations and Bible studies is required.

AWSOM Interns will participate in leadership and Bible Study activities led by Program Director as a team and will also lead the PHISH team in similar activities. Interns will create the following year's Winter Camp curriculum, under the guidance of the Program Director. They will also be involved in making Camp Arrah Wanna programs successful, including: Summer Camp, Friends & Family Camp and the Contemplative Retreat. The AWSOM Team will also assist in supervising PHISH students in their daily work and in sharing life together. Opportunities to facilitate or supervise activities such as: Ropes Courses, Archery, Lifeguarding, Camp Store.

Food & Lodging provided while you stay on-site at Camp (work and non-work days), valued at \$65/day

Program Elements: various outings, supplies, experiences, trips, etc. (valued at approx. \$5/day)

Flexibility & Desire to help you earn school credit for your work at Camp!

Multiple Bonus opportunities:

\$50 for volunteering at 2026 Winter Camp \$50 for recruiting another AWSOM Intern (who gets hired)

\$15 for each unused Banked Day off
