The Geomatics Technician shall assume the role of assisting on a number of resource management initiatives under the Lands department through a technical role in developing Thessalon First Nation capacity in inventory and management of values and mapping in a digital format, and to develop in-house capacity to compile information electronically so that it is readily available for use by the TFN community.

Scope

This position will support the community participation in resource management, engagement and consultation processes such as forest management planning, renewable energy project reviews, other resource development projects and in ongoing land use planning.
