

**WILLIAM LOUIS CALABRESE**  
**1928 - 1998**

Bill Calabrese, age 69, of Caseville died Sunday morning, July 5, at Scheurer Hospital, Pigeon of an apparent heart attack.

He was born July 24, 1928 in Utica, oldest son of Esther (Mamrow) Calabrese and the late Daniel Calabrese.

On April 3, 1948 he was united in marriage to Barbara Robinson at St. Lawrence Church, Utica. She preceded him in death February 28, 1980. On July 29, 1980, he married Angie (Tracchiolo) Mucaria in East Detroit. She also preceded him in death, October 26, 1996.
