### 1900 Water-Borne Semi-Transparent

#### Description

*Timberline Water-Borne Semi-Transparent Stain 1900* is a durable, water based stain that beautifies and protects wood surfaces. The nano-technology acrylic formula allows for deeper penetration into the wood substrate without forming a continuous film. This allows for more conventional wear mechanisms and so will not peel. It features excellent durability, moisture resistance, and easy cleanup. Designed specifically for Colorado's unique climate, *Timberline Water-Borne Semi-Transparent Stain* is an ideal stain choice for decks, railings, fences, or any wood substrate requiring a durable, semi-transparent finish.

#### Application and Substrate Information

Mix or stir thoroughly before using. Stain should be applied using brush, roller or airless spray equipment (2,000 psi, 0.013" – 0.017" tip). Maintain sufficient wet edge to prevent lapping. For proper performance, this product must be able to penetrate wood surfaces. For especially smooth or pressure-treated woods, sanding prior to application is recommended.

See General Surface Preparation for further details.

For best results, temperatures (air, surface and material temperatures) should be between 50°F – 90°F (10°C-32°C) before applying.

#### Clean-up

Clean all tools and equipment with soap and warm water.

#### Thinning

Not recommended.

#### Dry Time

Will dry to touch in one hour or less; for maximum durability, apply again after a minimum of 4 hours. Note that due to semi-transparent nature of this product, multiple coats may affect color development. Dry time may be affected by poor ventilation, low temperatures, amount of colorant and/or high humidity areas. Do not apply if temperatures are below 40°F.

#### Environmental/Health Considerations

Formulated without lead, mercury, and other heavy metals. Does not contain ethylene glycol. No reportable amount of crystalline silica.

### General Surface Preparation

All foreign material, including loose or peeling paint, dirt, grease, oil, wax, chalk, mildew, rust, dust, curing agents, etc., must be removed prior to use. Failing to do so may compromise performance. Sanding may be necessary over smooth or previously coated surfaces.

Recommended for wood substrates only. May be applied to horizontal or vertical substrates. Different color woods will develop different color appearance. Be sure to check the color over a small area to ensure the color is desired. Maintain wet edge to prevent lap marks from developing, especially over very dry or porous woods. Two coats are recommended for best durability.

If staining over a previously stained surface, ensure proper penetration into the substrate. Most stains contain a wax additive that can cause a water-beading effect. If the surface exhibits this property, sanding may be required to allow for proper penetration.

May be applied to dry or slightly damp wood.

### Packaging

Available in 5-gallon containers. Actual volume amounts of paint are indicated on the label. Volume is adjusted to account for the addition of colorants.

### Intended Use

To be used in a manner consistent with latex wall paints and finishes. Do not take internally. Keep out of reach. Keep from freezing.
