Gladys I. Dawkins, 88, of Sand Point, died Saturday morning, July 24, 2004, at the Huron County Medical Care Facility, Bad Axe. She was born August 22, 1915 in Sherbrooke, British Columbia, Canada to the late E. Stanley and Lillian (Nunn) Warrington. On November 10, 1937, she was united in marriage to Ferdinand Pringnitz in Royal Oak. He preceded her in death on June 29, 1964. To this union, a son was born, Glenn Pringnitz, who passed away in May 23, 1982. Gladys married Howard Dawkins on February 5, 1972 in Royal Oak.
