DESCRIPTION: Here is a Bob Lee (Wing) designed Colt Plainsman. This bow shows its age and has some wear and tear. It is a superior shooter, however. The bow has no delamination; no cracks; limbs are straight. No drilled holes; No chips or dings. No stress lines or crazing. There is one significant scratch in the upper face limb (see pic on page 5). This was not a stress line, but a deep scratch. A few minor scratches and nicks here and there. The finish is OK but not great. Decals are in fair-poor condition. The most significant flaw, and the reason the bow is priced as low as it is, is because of a repaired lower limb and tip (see pics on last pages). I didn't have the tools or materials to repair to original condition, and the bottom of the limb doesn't look great. But the repairs seemed to have worked. I put this repaired bow to a stress test (held at full-draw for 16 hours) with no failure. I have also shot this bow several days since the repairs with no adverse reaction. I would not recommend this bow as an everyday shooter, but it is a great bow for someone who would only use it for the occasional bow hunt.
