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New Recreation Center

The Buckeye Recreation Center is now complete. The 22,500 square foot facility was completed in February 2006.



The facility offers indoor tennis, basketball, and volleyball courts as well as meeting facilities and a fitness room. The Center also has various classes including aerobics,

Pilates, Yoga, and possibly martial arts. They hope to start various recreational sports leagues and other programs and events in the near future.

The Center will be open to anyone who wishes to visit; there will be general admission rates as well as yearly passes sold for use of the facility. An individual resident of Beech Mountain can get a yearly pass to the Center for only \$75.00; family passes cost \$150.00. For those folks that wish to use the Center that are not residents of Beech Mountain, the costs are doubled. Residents and non-residents will also be able to purchase the daily passes to the Center.

As a member of the Rec Center, Renée can attest that the fitness center is first class. There are two treadmills, one stair stepper, two ellipticals, one stationery bike, free weights, and a number of machines that work the arms, legs and abs.

The facility is open on Monday-Saturday from 8:30 am-8:30 pm and on Sunday from 12pm-6pm. As a member of the Recreation Center you will receive a swipe card that allows you entrance into the fitness area from 6:00am until 10:00pm.
