November 14, 2010We left the harbor about 4:00 AM heading for the back side of Anacapa Island, We knew there had been very large yellowtail roaming the area. Local sport boats were losing more fish than they were putting on the boat. I spooled up with fresh 40# Pline and prayed I would get the lucky bite. We were instructed by Captain Steve Kelly that we ought to be drop-shotting on heavy line, and that we would be fishing in about 90 feet. Shortly after our first stop we got three bites almost simultaneously, and fortunately for me I was one of the lucky ones. Up and down the starboard side a few times, then around the anchor to the port side. A few trips up and down the port side then to the stern, where Kelly told me the fish was whipped and to keep it in the port corner, as there was another fish on, in starboard corner. After several nerve racking vertical runs I finally saw the fish come from under the boat, only four or five foot deep. Steve immediately gaffed my lifetime best yellow tail and hauled it on board. That day we hooked six and boated four, of these fabulously beautiful fish with one of them over fifty Lbs. I won the Jackpot, as the fifty Lb fish was handed off to another angler. The jackpot was donated to the crew. This was of course one of my best days on the water ever, and I am grateful to have had the opportunity, to be in the right spot, at the right time,
