About this Tune Book:

Each Holiday Tune is played in the key of C Major. For a deeper understanding of the chords and scales that build these songs, you can use this tune book with the C Major page(s) of a Fretboard Toolbox Essential Edition (pages 11-14) or Complete Edition (page 19).

The whole point is to use these tunes is to build muscle and sound memory for common chord changes and melody patterns (& their sounds) in the key of C Major, so you can apply that muscle & ear memory to tons of other songs!

With the purchase of this E-Book, you will see a web address in this corner of the page that gives you access the TabEdit (.tef) files & backing tracks!

About TabEdit (.tef) files:

To play the .tef files, you'll need the free TEFview File Viewer (download at <http://www.tabledit.com/tefview>). This lets you open the ".tef" files, shows the TAB, and plays MIDI files for each song.

How to use this Tune Book:

There are two versions of each song. The "Melody Notes" version lets you play straight through the melody, and the "Melody with Chords" version shows you a way to play chords along with the melody notes. These versions will take some time to get down, but they'll go a long way in teaching you ways to move around notes and chords in the key of C Major that you can apply to all kinds of songs in tons of musical styles.

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Moving around in this E-Book:

1. To return to the Table of Contents-

Click on any yellow highlighted page number at the bottom of each page.

2. To switch back and forth between the "Melody Notes" and "Melody with Chords" versions of each song-

Simply click anywhere on the TAB line of the song you're on and you'll jump to the other TAB version of the same song.

Tuning:

3. All these songs are in standard tuning, & the notes are shown at the start of each TAB row to help visualize the note locations on each string.

Time Signatures:

4. The time signature of each song is shown in a maroon box in the first measure of each song. All of these songs are either in the usual 4/4 time (with four beats per measure) or 3/4 time (with three beats per measure, as in a waltz).

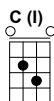

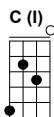
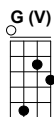
