

Dancing Dog Makes Fine Speech



A Boston bull terrier named Tarzan today returned to his Kelley's Island home after a speaking engagement in Cleveland.

Tarzan is 4½ years old and one of the ablest after-dinner speakers of his species, according to Ray Tacikowski, his owner and tour manager.

Tarzan repeats these after his master and with a willing ear you can catch his phrasing.

Moreover, he has other tricks, including sitting down when the matter is suggested by his master, which sets him apart from all after-dinner speakers of any species.

Tacikowski says Tarzan never had a word to say about anything until six months or so ago. One day in the kitchen of the Tacikowski tavern, The Casino, on Kelley's Island, Tarzan was watching Mrs. Tacikowski cook hamburgers and he said: "Hamburger."
