(November 25, 1924 - August 24, 2012)

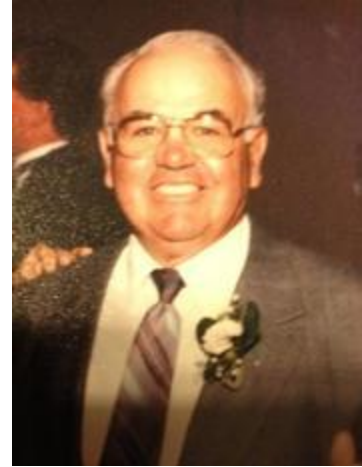


Felix Clancy, age 87, lifelong resident of Hume Township, passed away at his home, Friday, August 24, 2012.
