WDFW update on Cowlitz River fisheries

Hal has confirmed with WDFW that they will provide our program Tuesday. The speaker will be John Serl, a senior biologist with WDFW who is in charge of the Cowlitz River fish program. He's going to present an overview of steelhead hatchery production, the early winterization of the segregation process and then an overview of sea-run cutthroat production areas and maybe a bit on a radio telemetry study done in the upper Cowlitz. District fish biologist Josua Holowatz may also attend.

We'll want to start the program shortly after everyone arrives after 5:30 so they can do the program and leave. FYI, Hal also invited retired biologist Keith Keown to attend. He lives in Olympia but is going to try and be here.






....since we're having a little fun, here's a few pics from the soiree a few of us made to Georgetown Lake in September. The food was worthy and great to see Glenn again.
