

ORDINANCE NO. 94-3

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 83-10 AND 91-4 REGULATING
TRAFFIC, STREETS AND SIDEWALKS WITHIN THE CORPORATE
LIMITS OF THE VILLAGE OF CHAPIN

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE
VILLAGE OF CHAPIN, MORGAN COUNTY, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Ordinance 83-10, and Ordinance No. 91-4 shall be
amended by deleting Section 4(c) from Ordinance No. 91-4 thereof,
and inserting immediately following Section 4(b) the following:

SECTION 4.

(c) A 3-way stop shall be located at the junction of Ash
and Superior with stop signs posted such that all traffic
traveling South on Ash and East or West on Superior shall
stop.

(d) A 3-way stop shall be located at the junction of
French and Cooper with stop signs posted such that all traffic
traveling North or South on Cooper and East on French shall
stop.

(e) A 4-way stop shall be located at the junction of
North and Ash with stop signs posted such that all traffic
traveling North or South on Ash and East or West on North
shall stop.

(f) Failure to stop, as posted, shall subject the
violator to a \$50.00 fine.

SECTION 2. That Section 4 of Ordinance 83-10, after amendment
by 91-4 and this Ordinance, shall read as follows:

SECTION 4.

(a) Stop signs shall be posted at the junctions of
Cooper, Ash and Oak with Highway 104 such as to require
traffic entering onto Highway 104 to stop.

(b) A 4-way stop shall be located at the junction
of Congress and Superior with stop signs posted such that
all traffic traveling East or West on Superior and North
or South on Congress shall stop.

(c) A 3-way stop shall be located at the junction of Ash
and Superior with stop signs posted such that all traffic

traveling South on Ash and East or West on Superior shall stop.

(d) A 3-way stop shall be located at the junction of French and Cooper with stop signs posted such that all traffic traveling North or South on Cooper and East on French shall stop.

(e) A 4-way stop shall be located at the junction of North and Ash with stop signs posted such that all traffic traveling North or South on Ash and East or West on North shall stop.

(f) Failure to stop, as posted, shall subject the violator to a \$50.00 fine.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval as provided by law.

SECTION 4. If any section, paragraph, clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect any other sections, paragraphs, clauses or provisions herein.

SECTION 4. All other ordinances, resolutions or parts thereof, in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are, to the extent of such conflict, hereby repealed.
