PENTECOST - BEFORE PENTECOST -

If you go back and read the Old Testament, you will discover that Pentecost was one of the Jewish feast days. The Jews called it the Feast of Harvest, the Feast of Weeks or Pentecost (in the

Greek translation). It is mentioned five

places in the first five books of the Bible.

Today this feast is known as Shavuot and is a Jewish holiday that marks the beginning of the early wheat harvest, which means that Pentecost always falls sometime during the middle of the month of May or sometimes in early June. It occurs on the sixth day of the Hebrew month of Sivan which is seven “weeks” or 50 days after Passover. More importantly, the spiritual meaning is the celebration of receiving the Torah from God. During the journey from Egypt to the Promised Land, Moses received the Ten Commandments, the first ten rules that define the relationship between the Jews and God as well as between the Jews and themselves. And it is there that the Israelites received the Torah, where God devotes himself to the Jews as “the chosen people”, and the Jews pledge their loyalty to God in return. This event is one of the defining events of the Jewish people and the Jewish history. It’s a celebration of the perfection of the One True God who, in the old testament, wrote his laws on tablets of stone and on the same day, in the new testament, wrote his laws in our hearts. We celebrate the arrival of the Torah and we celebrate the earthly arrival of the Holy Spirit of God which is one of the defining events of the Jewish people and the Jewish history and our own.

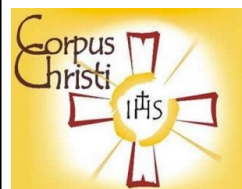
