Like most of us, I struggle to keep a smile on my face lately! I have turned repeatedly to two books on my shelves as antidotes to my fears. The first is A Chosen Faith (by John Buehrens and Forrest Church). This introduction to our tradition offers a summary of our faith, which I reread OFTEN to remind myself of what we can be in these current times and always:

individual. With Jefferson, we have sworn eternal hostility against every tyranny over the mind.

Unitarian Universalism is cooperation with a universe that created us; it is celebration of life; it is being in love with goodness and justice; it is a sense of humor about absolutes.

Unitarian Universalism is faith in people, hope for tomorrow's child, confidence in a continuity that spans all time. It looks not to a perfect heaven, but toward a good earth. It is respectful of the past, but not limited to it. It is trust in growing and conspiracy with change. It is spiritual responsibility for a moral tomorrow."

SIMPLY?? It is what our principles direct us to be, guided more by common values than by common beliefs.

### AND IN THIS, THE MONTH OF POETRY:

The second volume is <u>Devotions</u>, the <u>Selected Poems of Mary Oliver</u>. This American poet was known for her vivid imagery, clear observations, and awe-inspired observations of nature. Her work is characterized by a sense of wonderment.

Mary Oliver's perhaps most famous poem, known for its profound and relatable message, is "The Summer Day", particularly the final lines:

"Tell me, what is it you plan to do / with your one wild and precious life?"

Here is another favorite of mine (there are so many (3)): (FROM "WILD GEESE")

"WHOEVER YOU ARE, NO MATTER HOW LONELY,
THE WORLD OFFERS ITSELF TO YOUR IMAGINATION,
CALLS TO YOU LIKE THE WILD GEESE, HARSH AND EXCITING —
OVER AND OVER ANNOUNCING YOUR PLACE IN THE FAMILY OF THINGS."

I urge you to seek out your antidotes to the pervasive fears and choose instead the paths of love, kindness and caring in whatever ways are meaningful for you.

Fall of 1987	Unitarian Universalist Fellowship of Key West Inc became incorporated in Florida.
January 1988	UUFKW joined the UUA.
February 1998	UUFKW purchased 801 Georgia St.
September 2005 – August 2006	Rev. Barbara Jamestone, PhD, served as minister.
February 2007 – March 2016	Rev. Dr. Randolph W. B. Becker served as minister.
February 2012	One Island Family the Southernmost Unitarian Universalist Congregation was registered as our fictious name.
August 2014 – July 2015	We became a Teaching Congregation when we welcomed ministerial intern Kimberly Debus who served with Rev. Becker for a year. She was ordained on May 27, 2017, by two congregations – UU Congregation of Saratoga Springs and the First Universalist Church of Southold, NY.
2020 - 2021	Mostly Zoom services due to Covid 19 pandemic.
December 2023	Rev. Bob Murphy and Rev. Doug Slagle become affiliate ministers of One Island Family.
November 2024	Land Acknowledgement adopted.
January 2025	One Island Family officially designated as a UU Welcoming Congregation.
