

LONDON'S EYE OF SAURON

Molech means 'king' and it has several rendition in spelling. He is mainly a bull but was also an owl depicting the female and male attributes of this Luciferian god Baphomet. In certain literature he is the chief among Satan's Fallen Angels. Thus this 'king's eye ever keeps vigil of the Royal Residence of Kingston's Palace. This fallen angle required human sacrifices as some purport it was the case with Diana and others. The motif depicts the horned owl of Moloch as if perched atop the All Seeing Eye of Sauron. The Hyde Park 'Serpent' designed lake is depicted as if it is supporting the shaft or 'Tower' of Babel, a Stargate that opens the dimensions at such a palace or corresponding temple.
