WATER SOFTENERS

Water softeners should be checked to ensure that they only recycle (regenerate) as necessary. Regeneration should be based on flow rather than run on a timed basis. Water softeners that recycle too often have a *significant impact on the Villages chloride limits* and will also add to your water, salt, and electricity costs.



HOUSE NUMBERS

Section 6.16(c) requires building and house numbers to be affixed on the front of each building within the Village. Numbers should be at least 2.5 inches high and able to be seen by a person of ordinary eyesight on the public street. Please verify your home/building has a number that is easily visible for our local Fire Department and EMS should it be needed for yourself or one of your neighbors.

Village Ordinances:

6.17 Placement of Mailboxes:

Mailboxes are prohibited in the right of way of all streets.

Please examine your mailbox and make any repairs as the Village is not responsible for mailboxes that are damaged because of snow or wind.

7.12(f) Limitation on Chickens

No owner shall own or keep more than two (2) chickens or rabbits.

7.12(3) License Required

Any person who keeps chickens or rabbits shall obtain a license prior to January 1 of each year.

10.09 Display Vehicle for Sale:

It shall be unlawful for any person to display vehicle for sale on any street, alley, or public parking lot. Property owner must authorize and owner of vehicle must be on the premises or reside at the location. No more than one vehicle for sale at a time.

12.04 Remote Controlled airborne toys or devices: It is unlawful to fly or operate radio controlled airborne devices in, over, or upon any street, park or other public or private property except in areas specifically designated (Lions Park) or with prior consent of the property owner.

13.72 Outside Storage of Firewood:

No person shall store firewood in the front yard. Firewood should be neatly stacked not closer than 2 feet from any lot line.

These are just a few of the neighbor complaints received in the office. Please be mindful of your property.

BUILDING PERMIT REQUIRED

Yes, you need a building permit (well maybe!)..... Don't ask your neighbor, don't ask the guy who just did it down the street... call the Village office and get the answer to avoid the possibility of double the fees for not getting the permit as required.

- We DO require permits for sheds and no it doesn't matter what kind of shed.
- We DO require permits for fences, yes, even if you are just extending or changing an old one.

Please save the frustration and cost incurred by not doing it properly – you know your neighbors are watching and calling to see why you don't have a permit in the window. Building permit applications are on our website – fill it out, include a rough drawing, and drop it off at the office or in the night drop – I will contact you right away if the permit is not required for your particular work or I will forward it on to the Building Inspector. No money needed until we issue it.

ANIMAL ORDINANCES

Section 7.02 of the Village Code requires all dogs residing in the Village to be licensed with the Village.

Section 7.06(b) of the Village Code prohibits animals from running at large in the Village.

Section 7.09(a) of the Village Code prohibits owners from allowing their pets to defecate on another's property unless it is immediately removed by pet owner.

Poynette Police will be ticketing for non-compliance.

BRUSH PILE

Please DO NOT put your brush or clippings on a hot ash pile. This will cause unnecessary smoke in the Village or a possible un-monitored fire. The

Village does not burn painted wood or anything with screws/nails – please limit items added to the pile to just burnable brush and limbs. And, don't forget – You're on camera.
