Yard Waste Drop Off Sites

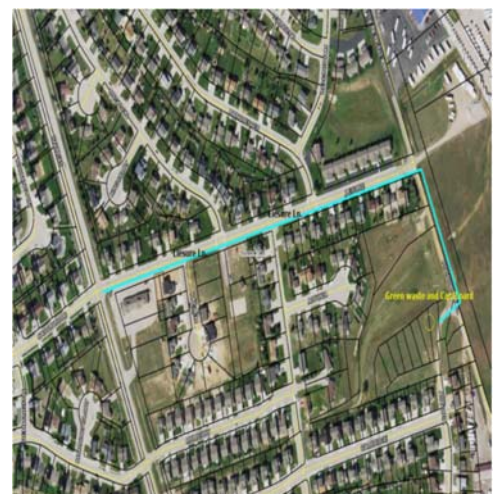
The City of Summerset has 2 yard waste drop off sites. One of the sites is located on Recreational Drive, just off of Leisure lane. The other site is located at the end of Glenwood Drive in Sun Valley.

Yard waste must be in paper compostable bags only. **NO PLASTIC BAGS.** Brush includes any wood material less than 6 inches in diameter, such as twigs, bushes, tree branches and small trees. Brush should be cut into 3 foot or smaller sections. Materials such as wooden fences, landscaping timber or building lumber are not considered as part of this service. The cardboard recycling containers are for cardboard only. Please remember to break down all boxes. Do not leave any yard waste next to the container on the ground.

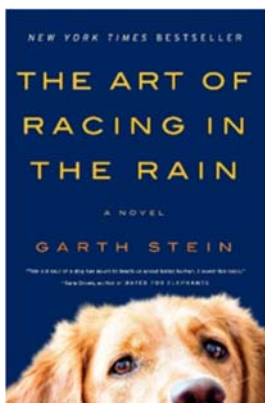
